



Clothing Guide 2026 / 27: Sixth Form

In the Millfield Sixth Form, all students are expected to dress smartly in business attire for lessons and to follow this guidance throughout the school day.

Sixth Form uniform does not need to be purchased in the school shop, except for school ties and sports clothing.

Personal Appearance

- Minimal makeup is permitted. Brightly coloured nail varnish or nails are not acceptable during the school day.
- Students must maintain a clean-shaven appearance at all times.
- Hair must be neat, tidy, and well-groomed, and must not impair vision. Any hair colouring must be a natural shade.
- Jewellery must be simple and discreet. Highly conspicuous items, including large hoop earrings, visible ankle bracelets, face piercings, body piercings, or visible tattoos, are not permitted.
- All students are expected to dress smartly and to adhere to this guidance throughout the school day.

Suit

- All students must wear a navy, black, or dark grey suit jacket with matching trousers, skirt, or suit dress. Suits should be plain or feature only a faint pinstripe or very subtle check. The suit jacket must be worn at all times around campus during the school day and may only be removed when in class.
- Trousers must be full length and made from a material suitable for holding a crease. Skirts and dresses should be tailored to finish on, just above, or just below the knee.

Trousers and skirt suits must be worn with one of the following:

- A formal, full-length sleeved shirt with a conventional collar, cuffs, and fabric, either plain or with a subtle pattern, worn with a school tie purchased from the school shop and with the top button fastened; or
- A formal, full-sleeved blouse with a conventional collar and fabric, either plain or with a subtle pattern, worn without a tie.
- Suit dresses do not need to be worn with a shirt or blouse, provided that shoulders are fully covered.



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- Shirts and blouses must be tucked in at all times. For formal occasions, including Head's Assemblies, services at Wells Cathedral, and away matches, all students are required to wear a plain white shirt or blouse with their suit.
- Suits must be worn with plain, smart, flat, dark shoes that are suitable for polishing.
- Dark socks must be worn with trouser suits. Dark or flesh-coloured tights should be worn with skirts or dresses.

Optional Extra

- A waistcoat made from fabric that complements the suit.
- A plain, tight-knit V neck or quarter zip jumper, dark in colour suitable for wearing under a suit jacket. No visible logos or branding are permitted. Round neck jumpers are not permitted.
- The jumper must not extend below the hem of the suit jacket.
- A smart, plain, dark overcoat may be worn. Large branding is not permitted, with the exception of a small discreet logo on the chest. The hemline of the coat must fall below the length of the suit jacket.
- Outdoor coats must be worn over suit jackets and not as a replacement for them.

Summer Term Options

- Students may opt to wear a suit in a lighter-coloured fabric and jumper.
- The jacket must still coordinate with the trousers, skirt, or dress. Separates are permitted (for example, chinos worn with a jacket), provided they match.

Sports Clothing

- All students are required to have the core items of Millfield-branded sports clothing (tracksuit, shorts, and top), which must be purchased from the school shop.
- Non-Millfield sports kit must not be worn around campus during the school day. This includes house hoodies, club tops, Kukri kit, tour tops, or any other non-school sports clothing. Such items may not be worn during academic lessons or sports sessions unless explicit permission has been given by coaching staff.
- Shorts must not be worn in the dining hall at either breakfast or lunchtime.
- Students wearing sports kit must ensure they have obtained a Kit Chit via the Millfield App.
