



Clothing Guide 2026 / 27: Year 10 - 11

Personal Appearance

- Only minimal make up is permitted. Lipstick, false nails or nail varnish are not allowed.
- Students must maintain a clean-shaven appearance at all times. Hair should be neat, well-groomed, and not obscure vision. Any hair colouring must be a natural shade.
- Jewellery must be simple and discreet. Highly conspicuous items, such as large hoop earrings, visible ankle bracelets, face piercings, body piercings, or visible tattoos, are not permitted.
- Daily school attire must include the regulation suit jacket at all times.
- All students are expected to dress smartly and adhere to this guidance throughout the entire school day.

Items not Permitted

- Footwear made from suede or canvas.
- Boots, sandals, or trainer-style shoes (for example, Nike Air Force or similar styles).
- Patterned tights.
- Sweatshirts.
- Gilets.

Uniform

All starred () items must be purchased at the school shop*

- Navy suit jacket. *
- Navy suit trousers (varied options or a navy, ankle-length skirt. Skirts must remain unaltered in length and should sit at, or just above, the ankle. * Waistbands must not be rolled.
- Current blue skirt may be worn for 2026-2027 on or below the knee. If not worn at appropriate length, then students will be required to buy trousers or the long skirt. *
- Plain white collared shirt or blouse.
- Navy blue striped shirt or blouse (available as an option for the 2026–2027 academic year only) *
- Millfield crested navy V-neck sweater. *
- School or house tie to be worn with a shirt. *
- Black or navy socks worn with trousers; navy tights or plain white ankle socks worn with skirts.
- Shoes must be plain, smart, flat, black, and polishable. Suede, canvas, boots, and trainer-style shoes (for example, Nike Air Force 1) are not permitted.



MILLFIELD

- Outdoor coats must be plain and dark-coloured, with a hem length that falls below the suit jacket. Gilets and coats with embellishments (such as fur trim or beading) are not allowed.
- Outdoor coats must be worn over the suit jacket and not as a replacement for it.

Sports Clothing

All starred () items must be purchased at the school shop*

- Reversible Sports Core T-shirt *
- Microfleece top *
- Warm outer layer jacket *
- Tracksuit bottoms*
- PE shorts *
- White sports socks *
- Games socks *
- Showerproof jacket *
- Towel
- Appropriate sports footwear
- Any sport specific personal equipment required, for example: mouth guard, cricket helmet, shin pads, rugby boots
- Sport-specific kit if playing or performing competitively e.g. hockey stick, cricket bat, tennis racket
- Optional items
 - Leggings *
 - Base layer *
- PE shorts must not be worn in the dining hall at breakfast or lunchtime.
- Sports-specific kit is optional to buy and may only be worn for sports sessions. It must not be worn for academic lessons or at any other time during the school day. On Wednesdays and Saturdays, core sports kit must be worn at all times; sports-specific kit is not permitted on these days.
- Outside Wednesday and Saturdays, students wearing sports kit must obtain a Kit Chit via the Millfield App.
