

# **Uniform Guide and School Shop Information**

The Millfield School Shop is located by turning left as you enter the school gates, opposite the north car park.

It offers a full and complete personal fitting out service for new and existing students. For new starters, appointments are available throughout the summer until the start of term. It is advisable to pre-book your appointment as early as possible; the shop gets very busy during peak times. When fitting a child, we allow for growth but are happy to exchange items assuming it has not been named and is returned in the same condition it was purchased.

The shop operates personal accounts for all students during term time. Students may purchase items from the shop, add them to their account, or pay for them separately. All items purchased on accounts must have a signed "chit" from the student's housemaster/mistress or guardian.

Sixth formers may write their own chits to a limit of £40.00 per day. Any arrangements regarding expenditure limits for the Sixth formers, should therefore be made directly with your child.

The shop offers a comprehensive range of products for all boarding and day students. In addition to Millfield uniform and games kit, the shop stocks various types of equipment, leisurewear, footwear, toiletries, a large range of stationary items, greeting cards and gifts.

Items purchased online can either be collected from the shop or sent to your home.

#### **Name Tapes**

Name tapes can be ordered from the School Shop in quantities of **144** or **72** (spares are always useful); please allow up to one week for delivery.

All items brought to school must be marked with woven name tapes which can be purchased through the school shop. The school shop will require the pupil's forename and surname to create the name tapes, please confirm with the shop when making your appointment.

Items which cannot be sewn should be marked with a permanent black or metallic felt tip e.g. contents of wash bag.



# **Clothing Guide Year 9 - 11 2024 / 2025**

To be purchased from the school shop (in person or via <a href="http://www.millfieldshop.com/">http://www.millfieldshop.com/</a>

Students wear either Option A or Option B uniform. No mix and match between options allowed. Formal uniform is worn for school functions and formal occasions, i.e. Head's Assembly, Wells Cathedral Service and away matches etc.

## **Personal Appearance**

Very minimal make up is permitted, no lipstick, false nails or nail varnish allowed.

Clean shaven appearance at all times. Hair must be smart and not impair vision, if dyed should be a natural hair colour only.

Any jewellery should be simple and discreet, no highly conspicuous earrings e.g., large hoops, no visible ankle bracelets, and no face piercings or visible body piercings or tattoos allowed.

Day to day school wear needs to include the regulation suit jacket.

All students are expected to dress smartly and to follow this guidance throughout the school day.

#### **Items Not Permitted**

Suits made from leather, shiny, skin-tight or stretchy fabrics.

Shoes made from suede or canvas.

Boots; sandals; and trainer-style shoes e.g., Nike Air force or similar.

Patterned tights.

Sweatshirts.

Gilets / Schoffel.

## **Everyday Uniform**

All \*items to be purchased at the school shop

- \*Navy suit trousers or skirt. Note that skirts should be unaltered in length, so they sit at or just above the knee. Students may not roll the waistband of their skirt.
- \*Navy blue striped or plain white shirt or blouse and the regulation suit jacket.
- \*Millfield crested navy V neck sweater
- \*School or house tie with shirt

Navy/grey/black tights or white ankle socks - with skirt

Shoes should be plain, smart, flat, black polishable, no suede or canvas, boots or trainer style (e.g., Nike Air Force 1).

Coats to be plain, dark colour, the hem to reach below suit jacket length. No gilets and no embellishments e.g., fur trim, beading etc.

Dark outdoor coats should be worn over suit jacket and not in place of.

# **Sports Clothing**

Reversible sports jersey, tracksuit top, tracksuit bottoms, PE shorts, trainers, white sport socks, games socks, waterproof jacket, towel as well as any personal equipment required for various sports e.g., mouth guard, hockey stick, tennis racket, cricket bat.

Shorts may not be worn in the dining hall at lunch or breakfast.

Students must ensure they obtain a Kit Chit on the Millfield App if in kit.



# Clothing Guide Sixth Form 2024 / 2025

In the Millfield Sixth Form, all students are expected to dress smartly in business attire for lessons and to follow this guidance throughout the school day.

Sixth Form uniform does not need to be purchased in the school shop, except for school ties and sports clothing.

#### Suit

All students should wear a navy, black or dark grey suit jacket, worn with matching trousers, skirt or suit dress. Suits should be plain, with a feint pin stripe or have a very subtle check. The suit jacket must be worn at all times around campus during the school day and may be removed once in class.

Trousers must be full length and be made of a material that can hold a crease.

Skirts and dresses should be tailored below, on or just above the knee.

Trouser and skirt suits must be worn with either:

a formal full-length sleeved shirt, with conventional collar, cuffs and fabric, in a plain style or with a subtle pattern, worn with a school tie purchased from the school shop, with top buttons done up; or

a formal full-sleeved blouse, with conventional collar and fabric, in a plain style or with a subtle pattern, worn without a tie.

Dresses do not need to be worn with a shirt or blouse, provided that the shoulders are covered. Shirts and blouses should be tucked in at all times. All students should wear a plain white shirt or blouse with their suit for formal occasions, such as Headmaster's Assemblies, Wells Cathedral services and away matches.

Suits should be worn with plain, smart, flat, dark shoes that can take a polish.

Dark socks should be worn with a trouser suit. Dark or flesh-coloured tights may be worn with a skirt or dress.

## **Optional Extras**

A waistcoat in a fabric that complements the suit.

A plain, tight-knit, V-necked or quarter-zip jumper, suitable for wearing under a suit jacker with no visible logos or branding.

Note - the bottom of the jumper must not hang below the suit jacket.

A smart, plain, dark overcoat with no large branding other than a small logo on the chest



Note - the hemline of the coat must hang below the suit jacket
 Dark outdoor coats should be worn over suit jackets and not in place of.

#### **Items Not Permitted**

Suits made from leather, shiny, skin-tight or stretchy fabrics.

Shoes made from suede or canvas.

Boots; sandals; and trainer-style shoes e.g., Nike Air force or similar.

Patterned tights.

Sweatshirts.

Round neck jumpers

Gilets/Shoffles.

## **Summer Term Options**

Students may opt to wear a suit in a lighter-coloured fabric. The jacket and trousers/skirt/dress must still match.

## **Personal Appearance**

Minimal make up is permitted, brightly coloured nails are not acceptable during the school day. Clean shaven appearance at all times.

Hair must be smart and not impair vision, if dyed should be a natural hair colour only.

Any jewellery should be simple and discreet, no highly conspicuous earrings e.g., large hoops, no visible ankle bracelets, and no face piercings or visible body piercings or tattoos allowed.

All students are expected to dress smartly and to follow this guidance throughout the school day.

#### **Sports Clothing**

All students require core items of the Millfield-branded sports clothing (tracksuit, shorts and top) which should be purchased from the school shop.

Non-Millfield sports kit may not be worn around campus during the school day. This includes house hoodies, club tops and Kukri kit.

Shorts may not be worn in the dining hall at lunch or breakfast.

Students must ensure they obtain a Kit Chit on the Millfield App if in kit.
